1 Introduction

The MILSET Europe General Assembly was officially opened by the welcoming words of MILSET Europe President, Antoine van Ruymbeke and MILSET President, Roberto Hidalgo.

All participants were invited to introduce themselves.

As per the statutes, only the members who have paid the membership fee are entitled to vote; 17 out of those 24 member organisations are present or represented at the General Assembly.

Unless agreed otherwise, votes take place by raising virtually hands and will be counted separately in the following order: in favour - abstention - against.

For a proposal to be passed, support from a simple majority (> 50%) is required, corresponding to a minimum of 7 votes in favour.

3 Organisation

3.1 Procedure

The procedure to become an associate organisation or member is as follows.

An organisation can contact or be contacted by MILSET Europe if they share the same values and objectives as MILSET. A candidature will then be presented first to the MILSET Europe Executive Committee and then at the MILSET Europe General Assembly, where the present members vote on it. If the candidature is accepted, the organisation becomes an associate organisation of MILSET.

Associate organisation can be both governmental and non-governmental organisations.

After a year of association, an organisation may apply for membership if said organisation is non-governmental, the members at the General Assembly will deliberate on the membership application.

3.2 Members

Before the vote, MILSET Europe was composed of 33 members.

4.1.4 Cross exchanges

MILSET Europe is having some recommendation on best principles in these exchanges such as:

- Deal only with organisation, not participants or supervisors
- Host takes in charge a full boarding during the stay for a defined population/period
- Sender takes in charge the international transports and extra days/services
- Finance is balanced on reciprocity.

Some of the attendees showed interest to send and receive students: Belgium, Russia, Georgia, Romania, Bulgaria, Germany. Bosnia, Denmark. Maybe Poland too.

5 Finance

5.1 Financial report 2021

MILSET Europe's 2021 financial report only contains income and expenditure of the accounts of MILSET Europe during the year 2021. It does not include all in-kind contribution provided by the Executive Committee members, the organisations, and other volunteers (including transport, accommodation and meals, materials during the activities, the meetings, and the missions) who spent numerous hours of voluntary work.

On 31 December, we had 22360,83€ with a deficit of 3376,67€.

MILSET Europe owns one bank accounts in Belgium:

The income for year 2021 was mainly composed by membership fees, for a total of 6400,00€.

The expenses for the year 2021 have been 5478,91€, and are composed of the missions, the meetings, some administrative supplies, some communications. These are relatively low in comparison with earlier years as the rhythm of activities was significantly reduced by the Covid-19 pandemics.

The financial report was put to a vote and approved (unanimously).

The total budget for 2023 stands at 8900,00€

The need to invest time and effort into networking at the European level to increase MILSET Europe's visibility and potentially increase the chances of landing a generous grant at the European calls is stressed upon.

Beside, following the pandemic, an effort to catch up and reinitiate the life of our organisation shall receive a larger support than usual for meeting and missions.

On the budget, the income from the membership fees does not correspond to the total number of members; this is because unfortunately not all members are in paying order.
